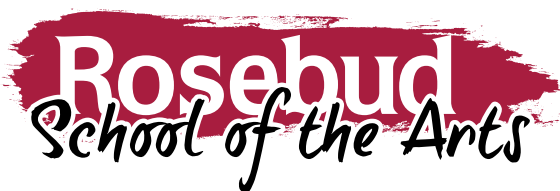

Show or concert attendance during Family Arts Camps is entirely optional. However, should you wish to take advantage of the performance offerings, the information below will help you choose the right event for your family.

Rosebud Theatre: *Spitfire Grill*

Tickets to Spitfire Grill include a buffet meal and a show. The entire family is welcome at the meal, but only persons age 4 and up are allowed in the theatre. Thursday Evening: Adults \$63.40. Students 13+ \$43.40. Children age 4-12 \$30.40. Children age 0-3 receive a free meal.

Friday Evening: Adults \$83.30. Students 13+ \$51.45. Children age 4-12 \$38.85. Children age 0-3 receive a free meal.

Theatre-only rush tickets are sold at the box office 20 minutes before performance time. The cost is \$15 per person. It is not possible to book rush tickets in advance. Availability is not guaranteed.
